Toynton-All-Saints Primary School Parking Charter School Year 2025- 2026

1. Parents and families agree to use the playground as a car park in the morning to drop children off at school, and again for the collection of children at home time. Staggered entry and exit times have specifically been created to support the size of the school site. Parents and carers are to adhere to the specific times below -

Little Acorns (Nursery):	9am and 3pm
Chestnuts (Reception):	8.40am and 3.10pm
Rowans (Y1):	8.40am and 3.10pm
Maples (Y2/3):	8.50am and 3.20pm
Sycamores (Y3/4):	8.50am and 3.20pm
Elms (Y5):	8.50am and 3.20pm
Mighty Oaks (Y6):	8.50am and 3.20pm

2. Parents and families will arrive punctually to avoid traffic build up and to safeguard the children. The gates need to be locked at 9.00am. If, for some reason, parents and families are not able to arrive by 9.00am, children will be admitted via the school office.
3. Parents and families will agree to driving at a speed of no more than 5 miles per hour when on the school premises. Should drivers not adhere to this speed, then they will no longer be able to use the playground at collection and drop off times.
4. Parents and families will agree to drive courteously, allowing other parents and school bus drivers to enter and leave the school premises without stress or concern. Should drivers not adhere to this etiquette, then they will no longer be able to use the playground at collection and drop off times. Parents and families should not leave the children until the member of staff is at the designated point to receive them.
5. Cars MUST reverse into their parking spaces to allow for ease of departure and best visibility for pedestrians around them.
6. Children of any age are not allowed to walk across the playground into the building by themselves whilst it is in use as a car park.
7. Parents and carers will escort their children directly to and from their exit and entry points and will not congregate with other parents.
8. Parents and families will not allow their children to run around the playground unescorted, or use the playground equipment, during these drop off and collection times and must assume full responsibility for their own children's safety on the playground during these times.
9. Parents and families are welcome to park their cars outside of the yellow school zones, on the main road. Cars are not allowed to park ON the yellow chevrons and will be asked to move if they do so.
10. No dogs are allowed out of the vehicles and no smoking or vaping is allowed on the school premises.

Valuing Respect, Relationships, Resilience, Risk-taking, Resourcefulness and Reflection

11. Parents walking their children to school through the main gate must accompany their children to the school door and must not let their children run or walk unescorted around the corner, onto the playground/car park during the collection and drop off periods.
12. Parents walking their children to school must walk with their children and must not allow them to run ahead. Walkers should walk a maximum of two abreast, to ensure the safety of the children and so as not to create congestion in the road.
13. Should parents and families not abide by the points laid out in this charter, then School reserves the right to disallow them from using the school playground, as its intention is to ensure the safety of the children at all times and is an “agreed intent” memorandum of understanding for all parties.
