### Our Vision for Maths

### The Maths Mastery Approach

At Toynton All Saints Primary school we use a Maths Mastery Approach and Maths No Problem. This is our third year of using Maths No Problem with our children in Years 1-6, this consistent approach has supported our teaching and provided an effective long-term plan for the provision of maths.



Children are encouraged to develop fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills through a concrete and pictorial approach. In lessons, children use Maths No Problem textbooks and workbooks. All classes also use concrete resources to ensure depth of understanding.

## What else do we offer for Mathematics?

### **NumBots**

This is an online programme in place to support children aged 5-8 years old to help develop fluency in mathematics skills. All children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 have access to this website both in school and at home.



### **Times Table Rockstars**

This is an online programme in place to support rapid recall of Times Tables. It can be played both online and via their app in school and at home. Within school, the children complete a set of 60 questions in 3 minutes, at least 3 times a week.
