Ofsted Inspection: 23rd September 2024

Following our inspection at the end of September, we are now able to share the report with our families.

We are really pleased that the inspection team were able to see what hardworking children we have and how engaged and enthused they are about their school. The inspectors spent time talking to children and observing them around school: in the lunch hall and on the playground. They were pleased with the pupils understanding of the school's 6Rs and how they can contribute to the life of the school, taking on roles within the school such as School Council, Eco-council and playground leaders.

Another highlight was the way pupils treat each other and understand the importance of respecting each other. They checked our safeguarding procedures and behaviour logs and were satisfied that these ensure we are effective at keeping children safe. They were impressed by the wider development opportunities that the school is able to provide: clubs, residentials, trips, wrap-around care and our support from our ELSAs. The pupils also spoke enthusiastically about the Sports competitions and how proud they feel when they represent their school.

We are also pleased that the team were able to see the progress that the school has made since the last inspection and especially in key areas such as the work we have done to further support our SEND pupils, the development of our Maths and English curriculum and checking pupil's understanding within lessons. The inspectors spent time in our Early Years classroom and felt that the children 'got off to a strong start' with a well-designed curriculum and the pupils have pride in their learning and achievements.

We recognise that there is still work to do on the curriculum. There have been improvements since the last inspection, but we still have more work to do, and we knew this was the case going into the inspection. As a school, we will continue to work to make our curriculum focused on the key knowledge that we want the pupils to know and remember. We will continue to work as a team, alongside support from the Local authority, to develop the curriculum to provide the best we can for our children.
