Forest School - Clearly named old clothing - long-sleeved tops and trousers. Wellies and full waterproofs. Indoor shoes to brought in. No earrings to be worn.	

- **Please label ALL items clearly so that, if lost, they can be returned to the correct child.**
- Please provide clearly named suncream and sun hat during hot weather
- A watch and/or stud or small earrings may be worn, provided that the child can remove these for PE/swimming/Forest School.
- Pupils are required to tie hair tied back fully. Unusual styles, e.g. dyed hair, bright hair accessories or patterned cuts, are not acceptable as part of the school uniform
- Nail varnish or gel/acrylic nails are not allowed
- If your child is chosen to represent the school for sports, the official school sports kit may be provided for them, which we ask to be returned clean.
